May 25, 2015

Tonight's message has very important information for graduating seniors. The preliminary graduation walk list will be posted in Student Services at noon on Tuesday. Students not on the walk list should contact Mrs. Haggerty for additional information.

Graduation practice is Thursday in the AHS gym from 8:30 - 11:30 and is mandatory for all students on the walk list. Be sure to be on time and we may get out early!

Graduation for the Class of 2015 is Saturday, May 30th at the USF Sun Dome with the ceremony beginning at 9:00 a.m. All graduates must be at USF in the Corral by 8:00 a.m. There are no tickets for the event, however, USF does charge \$5.00 for parking. I encourage all families and guests to arrive early for the graduation ceremony.

This is a very exciting time for our seniors and we look for to celebrating their accomplishment on Saturday.

May 19, 2015

Following the assessment window for FSA EOC exams it was discovered that calculators provided to students at Anclote High School for session 2 of the Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 EOC did not meet state specifications. Anclote High School provided students with scientific calculators test administrators deemed appropriate, however, we have recently learned these calculators did include prohibited functionalities. As a result, the Florida Department of Education has made a determination to invalidate all FSA Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 EOC assessments administered at Anclote High School during the recent assessment window. The invalidation of student scores will not be reflected in grades or credit earned in these courses. Additional information can be found on the school website and a letter will be sent home with impacted students on Wednesday and administrators will be visiting classrooms. I understand the impact these circumstances and decisions have on our students and apologize for the actions of Anclote High School that resulted in these consequences.
