The Class of 2021 proudly announces its graduation. The graduation ceremony will be held on **Wednesday, June 2nd at 9:00 AM, at the Anclote High School football stadium.** Though the ceremony begins at 9AM, students need to report to the gym at 8AM. In order to uphold the dignity of our graduation ceremony and to meet increased security requirements, Anclote High School and the Pasco County School District will follow the following procedures:

- 1. All students must attend graduation practice on Tuesday, May 25th at 9 AM in the gym.
- 2. Final graduation walk list will be posted Thursday, May 27th by 4PM, outside of Student Services. If a student is not on this list, they need to contact a School Counselor.
- 3. The graduates must carry their caps and gowns into the stadium. Additionally, they should not bring anything else with them except their caps and gowns. This includes purses and bags as there is no secure location for personal items. Graduates should enter and go immediately to the gym.
- 4. Students may decorate the top flat surface of their caps, as long as it is in "good taste". All decorum is limited to single dimension (nothing can be hanging or three dimensional).
- 5. Wrists bands are required for entry into the commencement exercises. Each graduate will receive 4 wrist bands. Two guests may accompany their graduate on the field. The graduate and these two guests should arrive to the AHS gymnasium by 8:00 AM. The two guests sitting in the stands should arrive to the field between 8:30 and 8:45.
- There are enhanced security guidelines at Anclote High School that include:
 No purses, bags or backpacks will be permitted.
 The only bags allowed will be diaper and medical bags. These bags will be subject to search.
 If guests want to bring cameras or binoculars, they may not be in cases; cases should be left in vehicles.
- 7. Balloons, flowers, signs, noisemakers of any kind (including, but not limited to, bull horns, cowbells, whistles and air horns), or laser pointers will NOT be allowed at Anclote High School.
- Immediately following the ceremony, Gigante productions will be taking photos of the graduates and families on the field.
 Also, immediately following graduation, graduates will need to pick up their diplomas in the designated area.
